REDUCING CONSUMER WASTE



ENERGY-STAR RATED PRODUCTS


Sub-Zero, Wolf, and Cove offer thirty ENERGY STAR rated appliances that exceed the federal minimum standard for energy efficiency.

Waste not

Responsible manufacturing is of paramount importance to us. We have made great strides in the conservation of natural resources throughout our manufacturing process and continue to do more year after year.

LANDFILL DIVERSION RATE

Our manufacturing facilities are approaching a zero-waste status, with a 96.5% landfill diversion rate at our Wisconsin facilities and an 89.1% rate in Arizona.

ZERO WASTE WATER

No waste water is produced in the manufacturing of Sub-Zero or Wolf products.

Harvest Haven

Every year, we host about 2,500 kitchen designers, architects, builders, and appliance dealers for product training and education. Part of our training includes a tour of our two-acre organic garden and barn. Throughout the training, our corporate chefs serve seasonal menus featuring fresh food from the garden. Nearly 65–70% of the produce used at our training facility comes from the garden.









3.94-megawatt SOLAR PANELS

The installation of a 3.94-megawatt solar energy system is expected to decrease annual utility consumption by 30% at our Goodyear, Arizona facility.
